DESCRIPTION

As consultant to the University of California, Berkeley, Siegel & Strain has written Historic Structures Reports for the Beta Theta Pi Fraternity (Ernest Coxhead, 1893), First Unitarian Church (A.C. Schweinfurth, 1898), Drawing Building/Naval Architecture Building (John Galen Howard, 1914), Gymnasium for the California State School for the Blind (George McDougall, 1915), California Memorial Stadium (John Galen Howard, 1923), Davis Hall (George Kelham, 1931) and McLaughlin Hall (George Kelham, 1931). Siegel & Strain also reviewed design and construction documents for seismic retrofit and/or code upgrades including ADA compliance for other buildings including Zeta Psi Fraternity House (Charles Peter Weeks, 1911) and Girton Hall (Julia Morgan, 1911).

Siegel & Strain also served as Historic Resource Consultant for the draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Hearst Memorial Mining Building (John Galen Howard, 1902).
