

## Lone Oak Farm, Alameda County Waste Management Authority

### DESCRIPTION

The Lone Oak farmhouse is a two-story wood frame house constructed in eastern Alameda County in the 1870s. The current owner, Alameda County Waste Management Authority, engaged Siegel & Strain Architects to investigate the structural stability, develop cost estimates and make recommendations for the rehabilitation of the historic house and barns. Siegel & Strain was subsequently hired as architects for the complete restoration of the exterior and rehabilitation of the interior, which had been altered over time.
